## Rumor

Rumor is a knitted upholstery by Bertjan Pot. Its design bridges the contrasting worlds of handcrafted textiles and the digital space to create landscapes of shifting colour and pattern intensity. It is the first knitted textile from Kvadrat Febrik made from more than 70% post-consumer recycled polyester, which creates its distinctive volume.

To design *Rumor*, Bertjan Pot converted an image into a set of randomly arranged pixels in four different colours, using the 'diffusion dither' tool on photo editing software. Subsequently, through a process of extensive, hands-on experimentation with colours and pattern scaling, he translated this design into a knitted textile.

Bertjan Pot: "The diffusion dither tool creates these very nice square pixels, which is perfect because if you knit, you're thinking in square pixels too. It uses a digital and technical process to create something very random and irregular, like the handcrafted element of textiles."

Rumor comes in nine versatile colourways. From a distance, it appears more uniform and muted in colour, but get closer and irregular quantities of pixel-like stitches, in four contrasting colours, reveal themselves within the textile's surface. These pixels are an integral part of the knitted design and are not added afterwards through dyeing.

Bertjan Pot: "My favourite way of using colours is to contrast and clash them to make them stronger and more vivid. Each textile has four colours, and they all react to one another. So, it was interesting to build a set of rules around how the dithering pattern affected the colour."

The textile is particularly easy to upholster on all forms of furniture: Rumor offers excellent elasticity, and its irregular pattern infuses the design with an extra dimension of vibrancy and ensures it flows over edges to seamless effect. Rumor suits all contract and residential applications.

## **Bertjan Pot**

Bertjan Pot is a designer with a fascination for construction techniques, structures, patterns, and colours. Taking material research as his starting point, he specialises in working with manufacturers to develop interior products that explore possibilities and push boundaries. Pot's notable works include his ongoing project *Masks* (the Netherlands, 2010) and *Random Lights* (the Netherlands, 1999).
