## Air 4

Air 4 is a classic curtain designed by Erik Ole Jørgensen.

Crafted from Trevira CS, Air 4 is plain woven, offering a matte structure that evokes a natural look and feel. Its light construction results in a soft drape, creating a delicate layer of translucent colour between the interior and exterior.

The palette supports the airy nature of the textile, with 21 nuances built up in colour groups. Each hue varies in intensity, from sky blue to violet, mint to dusty green, and from wax yellow to apricot. These gradients sit alongside a versatile range of both warm and cold neutral tones.

Air 4 is fire retardant and has superior lightfastness, making it an ideal choice for contract environments as well as private homes.

## Erik Ole Jørgensen

This acclaimed Scandinavian designer produced furniture designs during the 1940's and 1950's, many of which remain classics of Danish design history today. Ole Jørgensen designed textiles to compliment his furniture collections and in doing so created a complete oeuvre of work. Inspired predominantly by material and, in his textile designs, systematically applying the same nine colours, plus black and white, he created simple, covetable and uncluttered designs that are effortlessly elegant
