Hand knotted, 20,000 Persian knots/m² and hand woven 80% cotton, 20% pure New Zealand wool Maximum size 400 cm ×1000 cm (157 ½" × 393 ½"), ø400 cm (157 ½")

Spheres rugs bring a multidimensional, contemporary eye to traditional artisanal craft techniques. Hand made and richly haptic, they share traits and hues with the curtains in the collection. Notably, they fuse graphic and organic elements to express a vibrant sense of movement.

The sensuous expressions of the *Spheres* rugs derive extra depth from nuanced colour blends. These are meticulously calibrated to resonate with the rugs' refined materials and the particular character of each design.

Kanon Pattern Plow reinterprets the archetypal construction of Kanon. It alternates a unicoloured pile with pile-free ribs to create a rhythmic, tactile structure. An interplay of black and white cotton yarns forms the rug's background. Borders crafted with a denser ribbed structure complete its expression. The rug's colours match Kanon, opening a multitude of combination possibilities.
