Lumo

Lumo is a twill woven curtain reminiscent of a soft woollen upholstery textile. Suitable for indoors and outdoors, it is designed by Patricia Urquiola to express a strong connection with nature, also apparent in its name – Lumo – which means light in Esperanto.

Lumo can be described as a 'hyper-mélange'. Made with two yarns that each unite two hues twisted together, the curtain offers deep colour vibrancy from a distance and when seen from close-up, fine diagonal lines.

Characterised by duality, *Lumo* is suitable for exterior and interior use. The front side and back side of the textile presents an equally eye-catching expression whether viewed from inside or outside. One side has an energetic tone while the other features a more tranquil shade.

Available in 10 colourways, *Lumo* is created using a specially engineered yarn with increased UV protection, a water resistant composition and low-water-consumption dyeing process.

Patricia Urquiola's creative exploration of twill-woven curtain continues with *Lumo* – as opposed to upholstery – textiles. It represents a natural progression from Urquiolas' upholstery designs *Relate* and *Reflect*.

Lumo is well-suited to both contract use and private homes. It is particularly ideal for spaces, such as hospitality venues, where a relaxed, homely atmosphere is desired.

Patricia Urquiola studied architecture and design at the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (Technical University of Madrid) and completed her studies at the Politecnico di Milano where she graduated under the mentorship of Achille Castiglioni. In Spain, she was awarded the Golden Medal for Merits in Art and received the Cross of the Order of Isabella the Catholic.

In 2001 Patricia Urquiola founded her own studio where she specialised in industrial product design, architecture, art direction and strategy consulting. Creative Director of Cassina since 2015, she works with a roster of leading design companies. Patricia Urquiola also gives lectures at leading universities and has work shown in prominent museums and design galleries across the world.
