Due to the composition of natural fibers the curtain can hang longer depending on the height of the curtain, room temperature and humidity.

This might also happen for textiles woven in a very open construction or knitted textiles.

It is therefore recommended to avoid the use of weight, but an adjustment of the length might still be needed after a while. Also, a possibility to let the curtain touch the ground when hanging.
